For the first time in the Foundation's history, a majority (58%) of the Directors are women. By comparison, women directors at the top 100 public companies in Massachusetts has reached but 28%, as reported in the Boston Globe on November 7, 2021. Also 36% of our Board members are people of color.

The Board of Directors intentionally seeks a broad, inclusive and diverse representation in skills, gender, and race/ethnicity. Beginning in 2022, the Foundation will conduct an annual survey to benchmark demographic characteristics, expertise, and lived experiences of the Board, Community Members serving on Board Committees, and the staff. The aggregated data will be reported on our website.

The Foundation was established in 1999 with the proceeds from the sale of Central Massachusetts Health Care, Inc., a physician-initiated, not-for-profit HMO. The Foundation currently has assets of
